Twistep



Are you one of the many dog owners who owns a tall SUV and have a large breed dog which has a difficult time getting into your vehicle? If so, I came across a very clever solution for that particular problem.

The very simple concept is to insert a handy platform or an extra step onto the back of your SUV which attaches below the hitch to help your pets and you, get easily in and out.

I was intrigued when I heard of the TWISTEP and after I received it, it only took about 15 minutes after reading the instructions until it was installed. Once installed you have a very handy platform attached to the hitch of your SUV which easily tucks away underneath the bumper.

My dog didn't hesitate and seemed to know right away how to use the TWISTEP to jump into my Jeep Cherokee. I was very pleased, as I have sometimes needed to actually lift her, muddy and wet, into my vehicle after a romp on the beach and this will completely eliminate the muddy paw prints on my pants!

Another great thing about the TWISTEP is that it makes it so much easier for me to stack and tie things like camping equipment on the roof or to access those *hard to reach* places when I'm washing my vehicle.

The bottom line is that the TWISTEP comes in handy for many things, so even if you don't have a dog, you will still find the TWISTEP invaluable!

The TWISTEP Holds up to 500 pounds when using a Class III hitch, or 300 pounds when using a Class II hitch and anybody can easily assemble the product and install it on the vehicle. The TWISTEP is a product we deem *A MUST* for the SUV owner!
